APPLICATIONS MUST INCLUDE:

- ▶ A 700–1000-word essay that includes
 - (a) the focus and purpose of the article that you intend to write
 - (b) the potential of your scholarship to advance systemic theory, research, and practice grounded in a commitment to social justice
 - (c) current status of the project
 - (d) how your background and resources enable completion of the article
 - (e) specifically how you hope the workshop will improve your writing, and
 - (f) your mentorship plans or needs following the workshop. Persons whose degree was earned more than five years ago should explain why they are now taking up writing.
- ▶ Current CV

The selection committee strives to achieve balance of disciplines, areas of interest, and social locations among the workshop participants.
