## **APPLICATIONS MUST INCLUDE:**

- ► A 700–1000-word essay that includes
  - (a) the focus and purpose of the article that you intend to write
  - **(b)** the potential of your scholarship to advance systemic theory, research, and practice grounded in a commitment to social justice
  - (c) current status of the project
  - (d) how your background and resources enable completion of the article
  - (e) specifically how you hope the workshop will improve your writing, and
  - **(f)** your mentorship plans or needs following the <u>workshop</u>. Persons whose degree was earned more than five years ago should explain why they are now taking up writing.
