



Editorial Fellowship Submission Guidelines

Application Procedure

- Only electronic submissions will be accepted.
- Applications must be submitted via the FPI website:
<https://www.familyprocess.org/new-editorial-fellowship/>.
- Accepted formats: PDF or Word.
- All materials (statement of interest, CV, letters of recommendation, and writing sample) must be combined into a **single file**. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

Application Materials

A complete application includes:

- 1. Statement of Interest (2–4 pages):** Describe your interest in the Editorial Fellowship, how you envision the role of an editor, any influences and experiences you bring, and your goals during and beyond the fellowship.
- 2. Curriculum Vitae**
- 3. Three Letters of Recommendation:** Letters should address your potential for leadership, dedication to the editorial process, and commitment to social justice.
- 4. Writing Sample**
- 5. Source of Information:** Indicate how you heard about the Editorial Fellowship.

Eligibility

Applicants must hold a tenure-track or tenured faculty position.
